General terms of the competition:

•Age of the participants:

Students from the 5-th to the 12-th grade divided in two groups: 5-7 grade and 8-12 grade.

•Announcement of the results:

•Awards:

atlases, globes, books, puzzles, drawing materials, charters of honour

Terms for participation in the picture competition

•Picture size:

- a) minimum 30/40 cm
- b) maximum 49/70 cm

Pictures exceeding the specified size will not be considered.

•Materials:

There are no restrictions regarding the materials or the drawing technique.
The pictures must be in original form.

•Time period for sending the pictures:

The date on the post seal must be between 1 October and 25 October 2017.

On the back side of each picture in the lower left angle inscribed in capital printed letters or on a glued paper sheet sized 15/20 cm, the following data should be written:

Terms for participation in the essay and poem competition

1. The size of the essay/poem should not exceed 3 600 symbols – two standard typed pages, aligned on both left and right, font Times New Roman, 12 points;
2. All works must be author's works. A parent or a guardian must sign an affidavit thereby warranting that the work is original and consenting to the Creative Commons license 
3. The works may be sent by the author, a parent/guardian, or a teacher;
4. Each work must be accompanied by the author's name, date of birth, school, grade, address, telephone number, and contact e-mail;
5. Each participant may participate with one work only;
6. The work should not be published elsewhere or participate in another competition.

•Selection:

A jury of Bulgarian writers, evaluators of the matriculation exams in Bulgarian Language and Literature and specialists.

On the Open-Day and Exhibition, all participants will be awarded Charters certifying their participation. The awarded works will be published on the web-site of the EEOBSS Project and shown in an exhibition which will be opened on 2 November 2017.

Upon the competition's conclusion, the works will be submitted to the European Space Agency (ESA) and they might be used in other educational or dissemination campaigns of the Agency.
